



Core Digital Learning Platforms



Google Meet is CIS's primary platform for synchronous (live) instruction and student/class meetings. Google Meet can be joined directly from the calendar invite sent from the meeting organizer.



The **Google Hangouts** chat function is also useful for facilitating communications between students and teachers. Both **Google Hangouts** and **Google Meet** are available for use on computers and through apps on mobile devices.



Seesaw is our primary learning platform in the Elementary School (Early Years-Grade 5). Seesaw is a one-stop location for viewing instructional videos, learning activities, and messages. Students can respond to assigned activities and upload work (pictures, videos, drawings, etc.) that can be commented on by the teachers, students, and family members and form a portfolio for future access.



Google Classroom is our primary learning platform in the Middle/High School and is used all the time (even when on campus). Students are therefore accustomed to managing their work, discussions, and assignments through this platform. All class assignments, videos, and announcements will be housed in Google Classroom.



Google Sites is used in the MYP as an individual educational portfolio. Students are required to upload their learning experiences, reflections and samples of formative and summative assessments to this platform.



HUB is our Student Management System (SMS) and it contains student and family records, health, attendance, and reporting modules. Parents can access HUB at any time to view their children's attendance records and report cards.



Plus various specialized applications/platforms which are used at different grade levels and for different subjects (IXL, BrainPop, Raz Kids, Spelling City, MyiMath, Google Suite, etc.)
