Sneak Peak (Kinatarkan)

Several months ago, the upper elementary students began learning about desalinators and started constructing them during Week Without Walls. From here, due to the commanding construction, the Environmental Club and a couple of students from Grade 5, as part of the Exhibition, decided to take over the project. Each group worked in conjunction with representatives from Cordaid to construct the desalinators. On April 26, the desalinators were donated as a gift to community members of the island of Kinatarkan, Bantayan by Cordaid representative and CIS parent, Anat Prag. The government officials of the Santa Fe municipality and province of Cebu were very appreciative of the gift from the students. With the desalinators being mostly constructed by students, the hope was to inspire and motivate families in the area to construct their own desalinators. The event as a whole also highlighted the critical water deficit of the island and hoped to make a positive change in water availability and strategies to protect water for members of the island community.
